

OBSERVATION DRAWING

Find a spot outside where you can sit comfortably for several minutes. Take a moment to notice what you see. Choose one object that is interesting to you. Try these drawing methods to make observations about your object.

CONTOUR DRAWING

With your eyes on your object, put the tip of your pencil onto the paper.
Without lifting your pencil or looking at the paper, draw the outline of your object.
Keep your eyes on the object the whole time!

SHAPE DRAWING

What shapes can you find in the object? Make a drawing of your object using triangles, circles, rectangles, and any other shapes you see in it.
